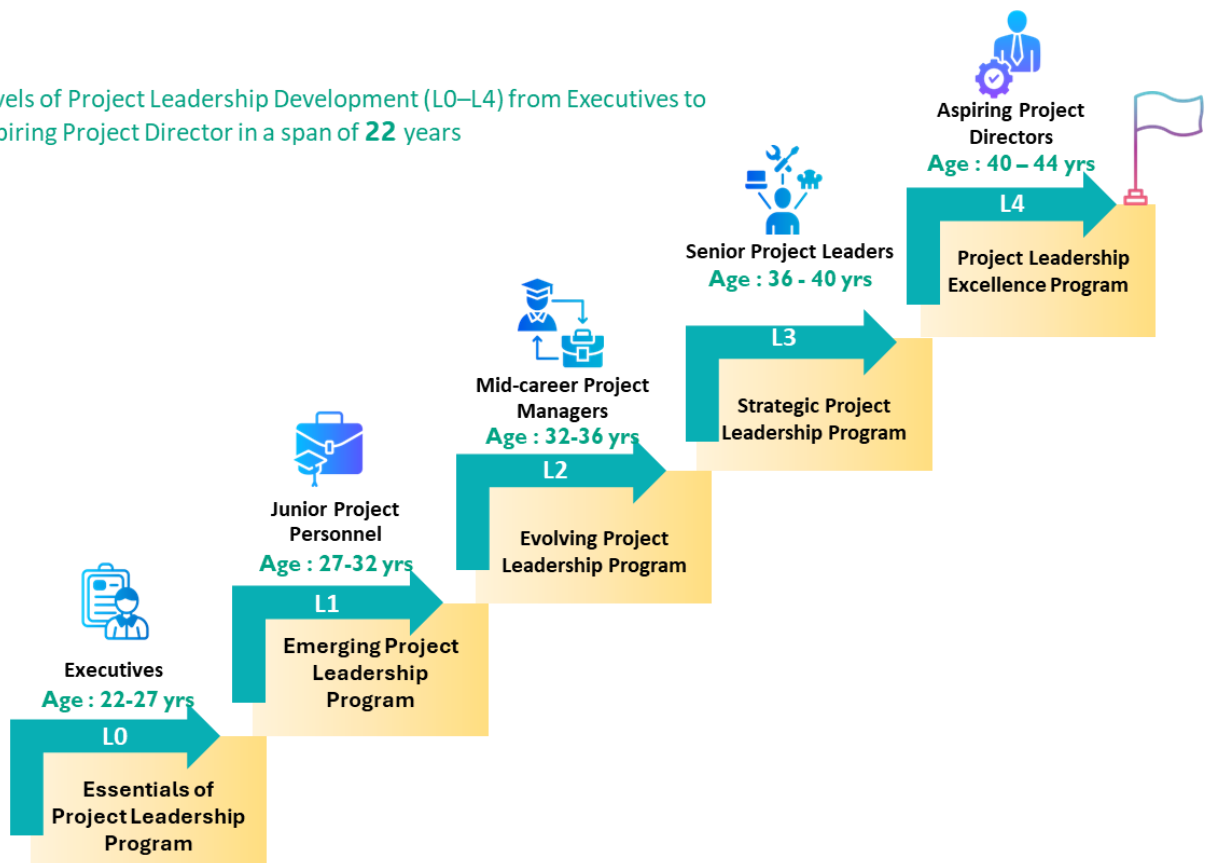
1. Programs for L&T Group Companies

Levels of Project Leadership Development (L0–L4) from Executives to Aspiring Project Director in a span of **22** years

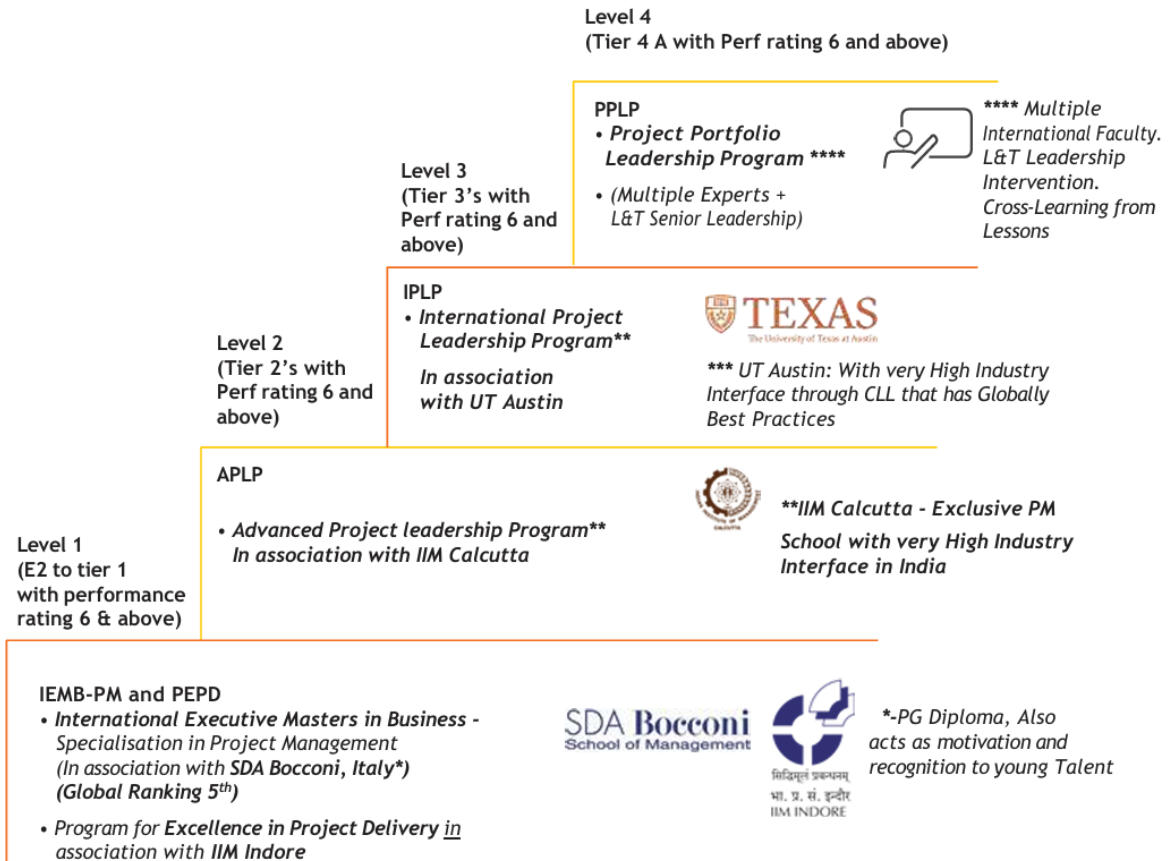


b. PRAGATI (4-Step Career Progression Programs)

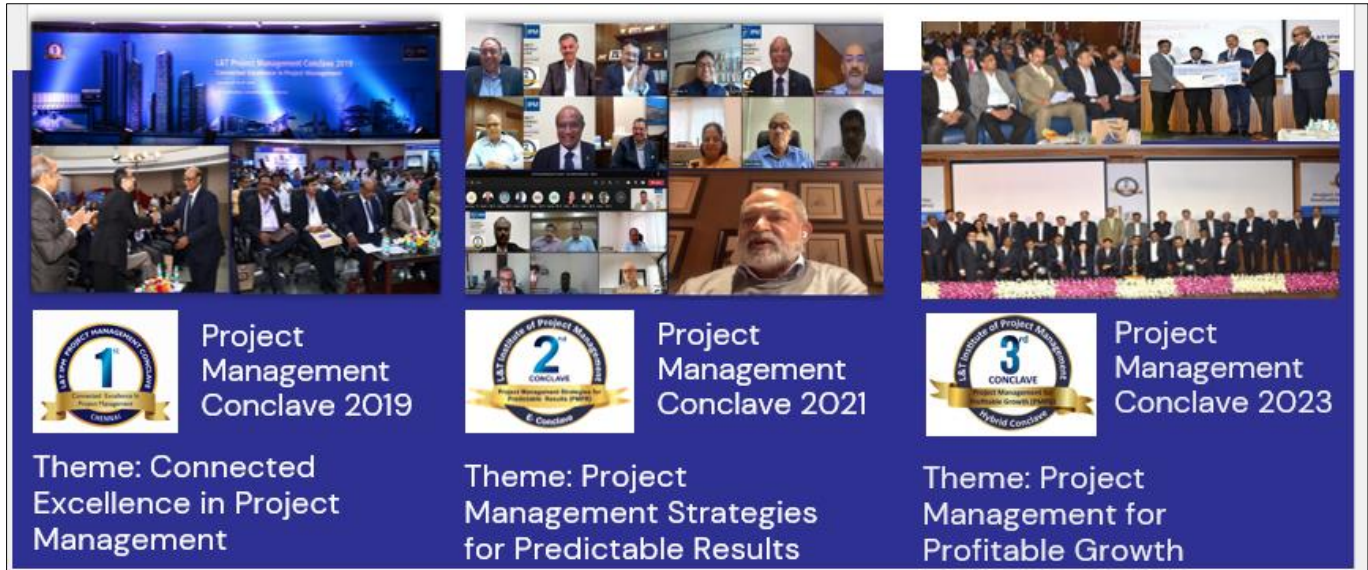

Project Management Conclave

L&T IPM organises a conclave every two years with the objective of connecting L&T project professionals and promoting knowledge sharing of best practises, along with providing a platform where project success stories and methods employed to achieve them are shared across L&T group companies. The Knowledge shared in the conclave is published as conclave compendium.



Knowvember

Knowvember (KNOWledge" + NOVember = KNOWvember) is a Knowledge Management (KM) initiative by IPM focused on promoting a knowledge sharing culture among L&T employees by creating a KM repository that can help employees seek and contribute contemporary knowledge.

Knowvember is a biannual event that helps employees assess their current knowledge level and test their ability to put that knowledge to use. A range of events such as experience sharing by project teams on lessons from execution challenges, demonstration of Project Management knowledge by executing simulated projects with multiple stakeholders, watching project videos and participating in quizzes based on the video, listening to Authors of popular project management books, book fair exhibiting books on contemporary project management trends, Panel discussions by eminent academicians and project professionals and many more events.



Capturing Field Knowledge

With the width and breadth of L&T projects, Knowledge at work is continuously evolving. L&T IPM captures this knowledge through its in-house journal and the case centre and propagates the knowledge to the wider audience.

Journal of Project Management: PRISM

PRISM is a quarterly publication of L&T Institute of Project Management.
