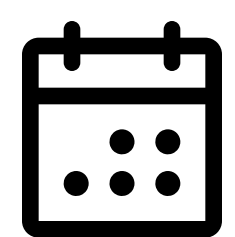

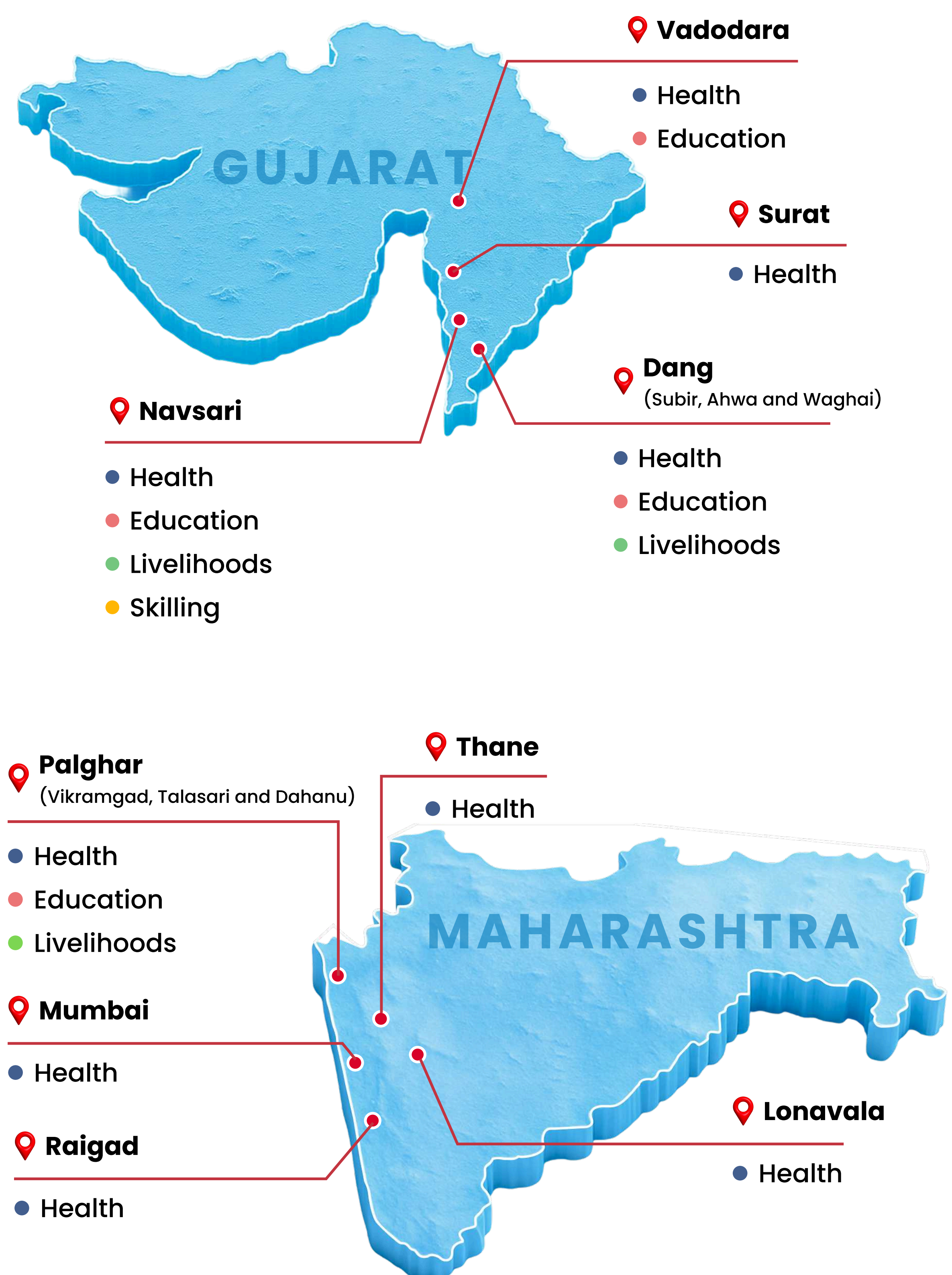

## Driving Impact Together

Collaborations with Kotak, Mizuho, and Redington strengthen scale, strategy, and grassroots impact

Recent partner engagements across projects highlighted the strength of LTPCT's collaborative approach where strategic alignment meets on-ground impact.

On 10 February 2026, a Mizuho Bank delegation including Ms. Akita San, Global CSR and Ms. Shachi Kaul, Head HR and CSR India, visited Tetvali village, Vikramgad, witnessing integrated interventions across digital education, health, and livelihoods.

## AI in Action

### Transforming Classrooms in Navsari

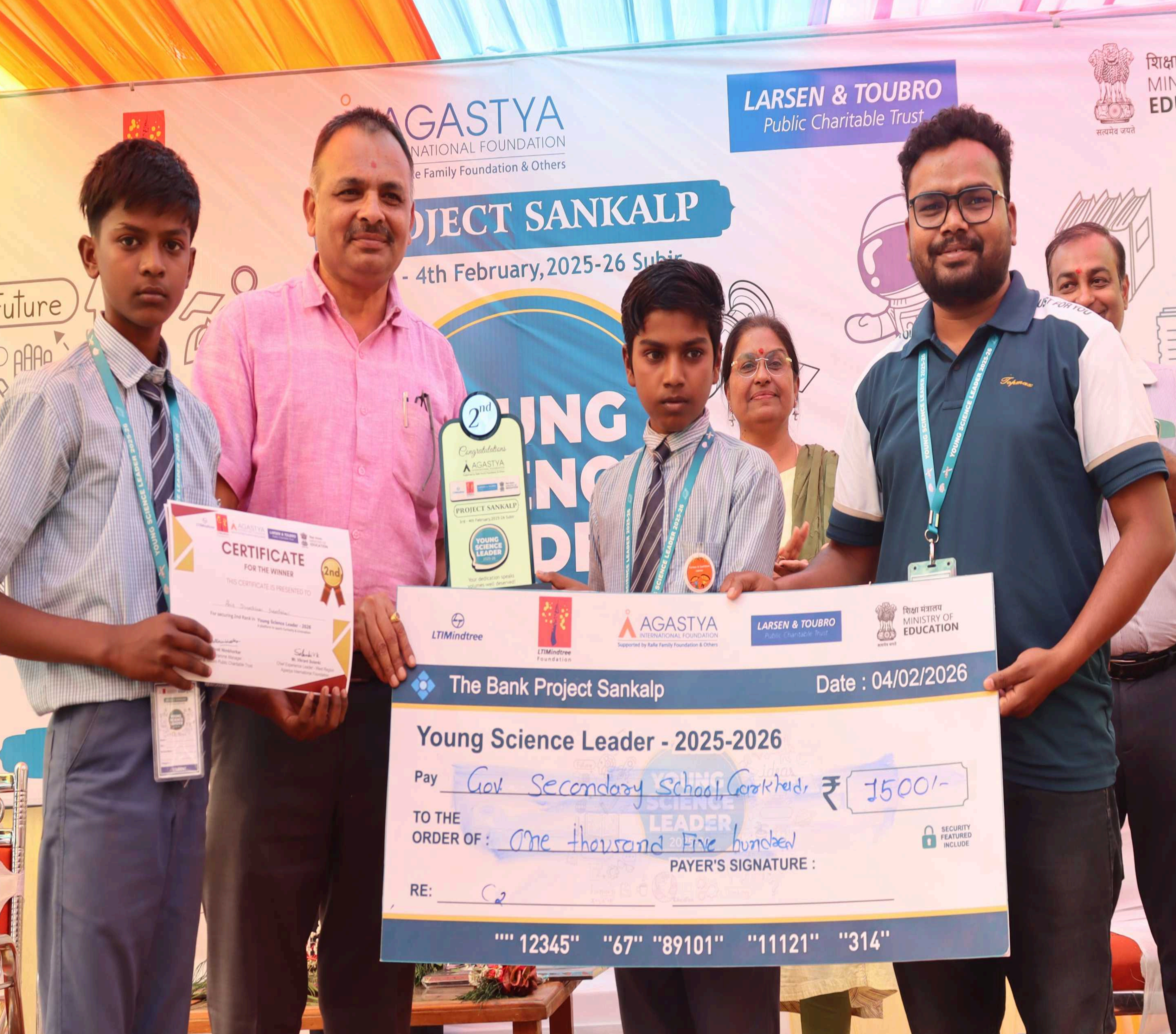
To address gaps in foundational literacy and numeracy, the Centre for Teacher Training (CTT), with GCERT's approval, launched a Microsoft AI training initiative for government school teachers in Navsari, Gujarat aligned with the National Education Policy 2020.

In a pilot, 120 teachers from 120 schools across six blocks underwent a two-day, in-person training in January 2026.

The initiative has gained national recognition, with work showcased at Microsoft's headquarters in Hyderabad and featured in a reputed academic journal GOEIRJ ISSN: 2278-5639 highlighting its potential for scale and impact.

## Fostering Innovation Igniting Curiosity & Change

February 2026 marked a leap in experiential learning in Subir block, as students showcased innovation, scientific thinking, and digital skills through a series of large-scale initiatives led by LTPCT under Project Sankalp in partnership with LTI Mindtree.

## Classroom to Creation Subir's Students Lead the Way

The Young Science Leaders programme, held on 3rd and 4th February 2026 at Uttar Buniyadi Ashramshala, Singhana, brought together 100 students from 35 schools.

Presenting 50 science models, students simplified complex concepts through hands-on innovation, engaging nearly 3,000 visitors and driving peer-to-peer learning.

Complementing this, Digital Melas across 26 schools engaged over 1,200 students. The Taluka-Level Digital Mela on 19 February 2026 at BRC Bhavan, Subir, saw 52 students from 17 schools demonstrate projects using tools like PowerPoint, Excel, Scratch, and basic programming blending STEM with foundational learning in an interactive format.

More than events, these platforms built confidence, creativity, and real-world problem-solving—highlighting the power of experiential and tech-enabled education in rural classrooms.

## Milking Change

### Women Power a Dairy Revolution

In Burthadi village, Subir block of Dangs district, women have transformed traditional livestock rearing into a sustainable and profitable enterprise. What began as low-income ownership of unproductive cattle has evolved into a women-run Milk Producers' Cooperative Society, established on 25 January 2025 with support from LTPCT and LTI Mindtree.

Starting with 18 women, the cooperative introduced structured milk collection, transparent systems, and fair pricing quickly building trust and expanding to over 44 members. With training in animal husbandry and access to veterinary support, milk productivity and quality improved significantly. In its first year, the cooperative sold 89,588 litres of milk, generating revenues of ₹34.4 lakh and a net profit of ₹21.5 lakh. Members now earn ₹7,500–₹10,000 per month, with several families reducing migration and investing further in livestock.

## Screening for Change

### Early detection, awareness, and care converge to address a critical tribal health challenge

Launched on 19 June 2025 in Vikramgad block, Palghar, the Sickle Cell Screening Project—implemented with the Public Health Department focuses on early detection and awareness under the National Sickle Cell Anemia Elimination Mission.

Through community-based screening, it has reached over 38,000 individuals across Malwada and Kurze, with 150+ frontline workers trained in screening, counselling, and data management.

## Health Meets Play

Interactive melas drive awareness, screening, and behaviour change in Subir

From 5th to 17th January 2026, LTPCT organised Adolescent Melas across 16 villages in Subir block, engaging 2,059 participants including adolescents, teachers, and frontline workers.

Moving beyond traditional awareness, the *melas* used games and hands-on activities—like *Poshan Chakra* and nutrition based play to make learning on hygiene, nutrition, and anemia engaging and relatable.

By blending fun with function, the initiative strengthened awareness, enabled early diagnosis, and put adolescent health at the centre of community action.

## Youth to Change-Makers

LTPCT-led program driving grassroots leadership and learning impact

Under the Vidyaa initiative, the Youth Development Program deployed 17 young leaders across communities to drive measurable change. In partnership with Veer Narmad South Gujarat University and IIM Jammu, the program combined on-ground action with system strengthening.

The impact was that all students gained confidence, classroom engagement rose by 55%, and digital and writing skills saw sharp improvement.

Beyond classrooms, the initiative built aspirations, strengthened systems, and proved that empowered youth can transform communities one leader at a time.

## Renewed Life

### From Dialysis to Recovery

At 70, Bharatkumar Patel's life took a critical turn when long-standing hypertension and diabetes led to kidney failure. What followed was a demanding journey from dialysis at L&T Health and Dialysis Centre, Surat, to a successful kidney transplant after over a year of waiting.

Despite initial challenges, he adapted to dialysis with discipline, showing remarkable improvement in health parameters. His resilience, combined with continuous medical support, led to a life-changing transplant and a steady recovery.

Today, with restored health and renewed hope, his journey stands as a testament to timely care, perseverance, and the power of quality healthcare.

## Income Transformation

### From migration to monthly stability

For Jayantibhai Patel, a tribal farmer from Vansda, farming meant low income and seasonal migration. With support for a creeper *mandap* and technical training, he adopted ivy gourd cultivation.

His income surged from ₹7,000 to ₹65,000, enabling year-round earnings, inter-cropping benefits, and a complete shift from migration to stable, local livelihood.

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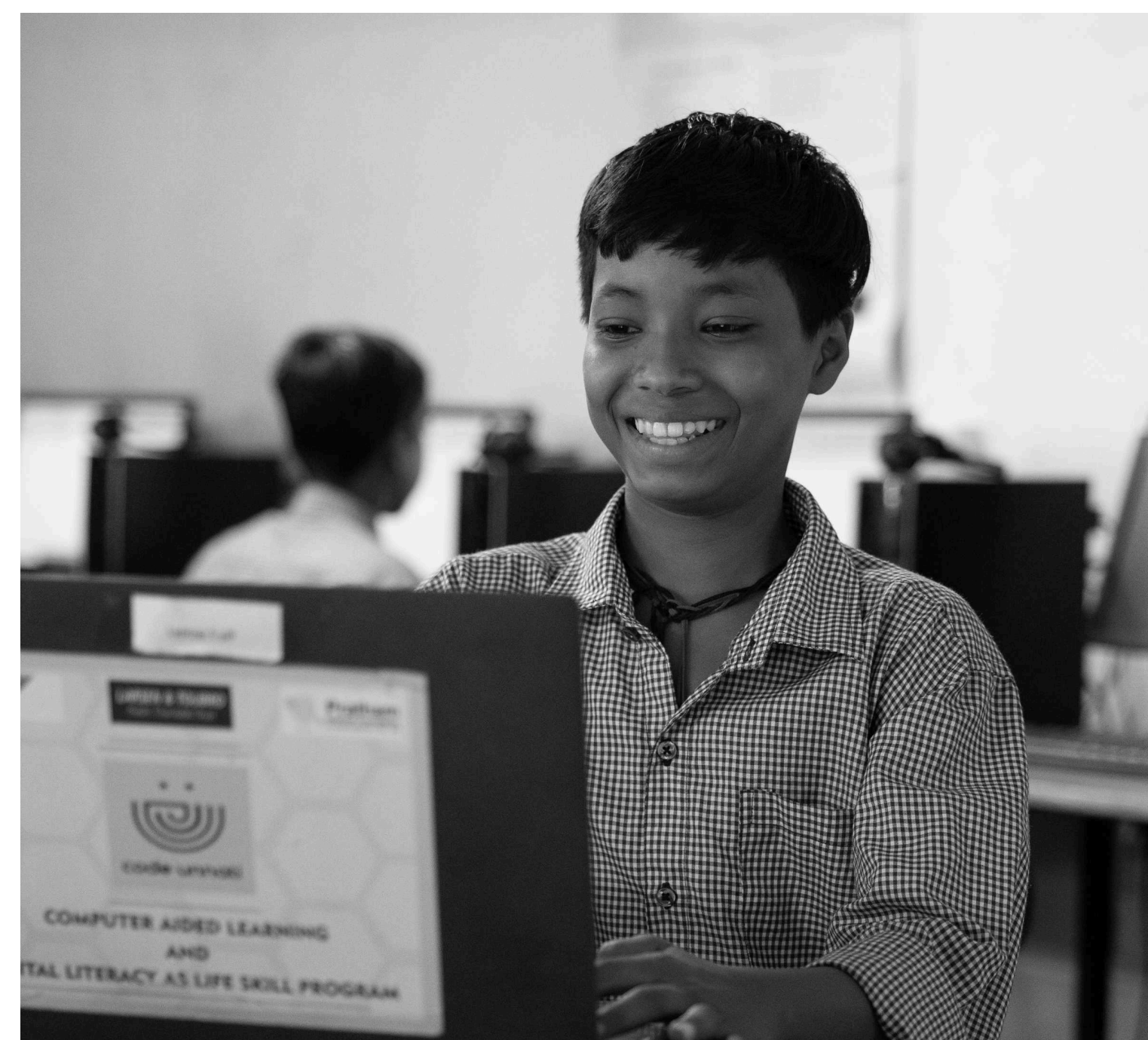
